
Year Designer 1976 – 2021 Giotto Stoppino

Celebrating stainless steel in the Bauhaus tradition, the tubular chrome-framed Jot chair takes its swooping, balletic form into the contemporary era with a new version purified of any paint or dye that would hide the essence of its powerful metal and rawhide leather elements. An iconic example of Giotto Stoppino masterful use of cantilevered chair styles and his exploratory method with materials.

Double saddle-hide upholstery in black, dark grey, foca, turtledove, testa di moro, brown, natural looks like the seat frame, available in matt nickel black or chrome painted finishes.
